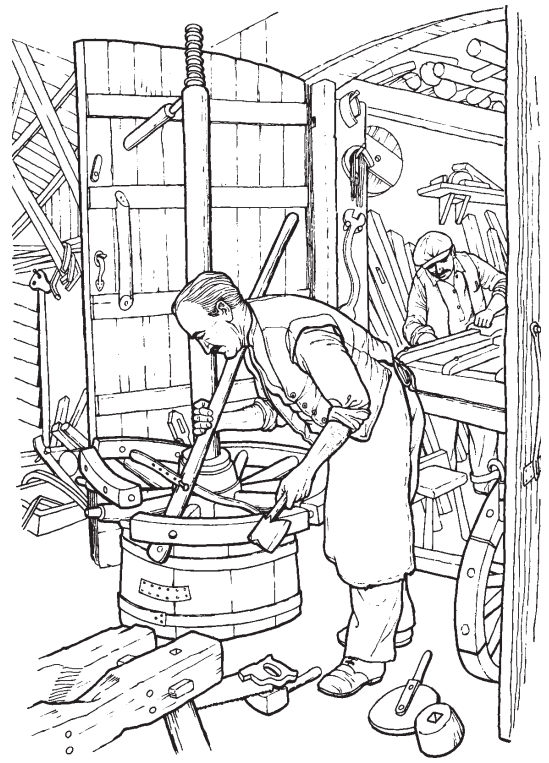

Craftspeople • living history re-enactors • speakers presentations and/or programs.

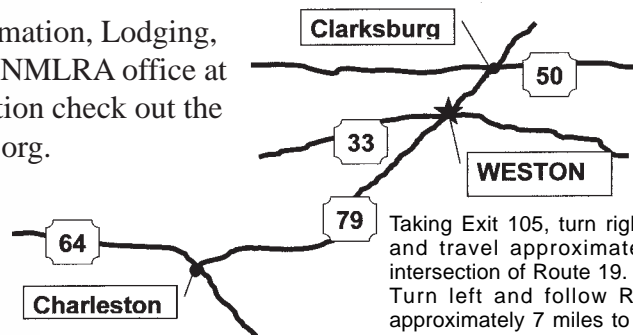
Top Prizes include: a Whitetail Deer Hunt, Whitewater Rafting trips, a Traditions muzzleloading rifle, and leather shooting bags.
