# NMLRA Scholarship - General Information and Criteria for an Award

The following general information and criteria pertain to the scholarship offered by the National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association. The NMLRA will award <u>two</u> scholarships in the amount of \$1000.00 each, per year to qualified applicants. Gunmaker's Hall will present one \$1000.00 Scholarship. Scholarships are based on such criteria as academic achievement, community involvement, major emphasis of study, students may attend a 2 or 4 yr College, a Technical or Trade School such as, but not limited to Plumbing, Electrical, Culinary, Cosmotology, ect; and financial need.

### Applicants do not have to be U. S. citizens.

- 1. Applications must be received at the NMLRA office for consideration no later than the following date:

  Deadline July 31st
- 2. Applicants must be members in good standing or a direct dependent of an immediate family member or guardian in good standing of the NMLRA. Good standing is defined as a member whose dues are current and who has been a continuous member for one year prior to the date of application.
- \* Applicants that are a direct dues paying member will receive higher consideration.
- 3. A most recent transcript of high school and college grades (if applicable) must accompany this application. Please include a recent 5x7 photograph of yourself.

#### **Incomplete application packets will not be considered!**

- \* Do not submit an application prior to graduating from high school, thus not providing all necessary documentation.
- 4. To be eligible for consideration for this Scholarship, a minimum High School Grade Point Average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale must be proven. Eligibility to include an ACT composite score of 19 or higher, or a SAT composite score of 1250 or higher. *Priority will be given to those students who rank in the upper 10% of their graduating class*.
- 5. Eligibility for currently enrolled College or University students must have maintained a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.5 on a 4.0 maximum scale, or the equivalent, which may be implemented at other academic institutions.

  <u>College student applications that includes high school grade transcripts with ACT or SAT scores will greatly improve a students consideration, no matter the year of study.</u>
- 6. Economic status and need of an applicant will be considered a favorable factor when all other conditions appear equal. *Applicants that show active participation at NMLRA events will be eligible for higher consideration in that respective area.*
- 7. An awarded scholarship will be held until a paid-in-full receipt for tuition, or other proof of enrollment in a College, University, Technical or Trade School has been received by the NMLRA Office. Non-receipt of proof of enrollment will disqualify the awardee, with consideration then given to next best, qualified applicant.
- 8. All applicants will be notified as soon as possible as to their award status.
- 9. You may attach additional pages if you need more space. This is recommended for the Gunmaker's Hall application pictures will enhance application.
- 10. If you were not chosen for a scholarship grant, please feel free to submit a new application next year, accompanied with all required transcripts. Those who apply for the Gunmaker's Hall Scholarship will also be considered for the NMLRA Scholarships.
